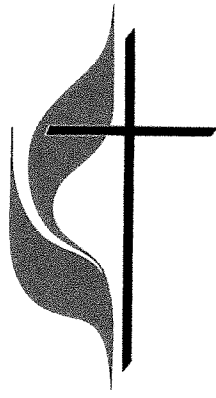

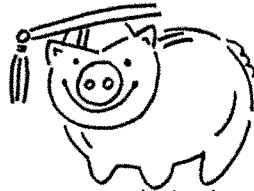


Become Part of Our Church Family

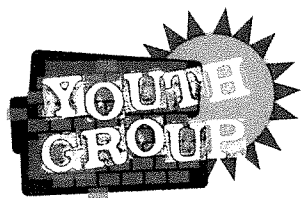

On March 22 at the Administrative Council meeting a vote of support was given to change the administrative committee structure of the church. The new structure will have the administrative council comprised of people representing all areas of the church as nominated by the Lay Leadership committee. Four other Ministry Teams of this church will be created which will answer to the council. These four focus areas of the church will be trustees (areas relating to the buildings), missions/outreach (ministries to our community and beyond), Discipleship (small groups, education aspects of growing strong people of faith within our church) and Preschool (connecting the mission of church and preschool in reaching children and their families). The functions of the previous finance and staff parish committees will be within the new Council.

This change will create a process in which decision making will be faster and more efficient, the overall mission and vision of the church will be united in all ministries of the church allowing us to move forward into ways God is calling us as a faith community. We understand that the next year will be a growing year in which we make adjustments as we try this new model to make it applicable to Roseland UMC.

A church vote is required by all members to change church structure. The church vote will be held on Sunday, April 29th at 3:00 in the Fellowship Hall. Look for opportunities for questions and discussion throughout the month of April prior to this church vote. 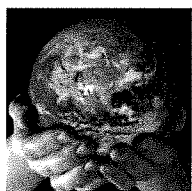
Isn't It Amazing?! School only has 44 days left (not including Spring break and weekends) which means Summer is almost here. And with Summer comes Warren

Prayer Garden

Have you visited the Prayer Garden lately? It is really lovely. A number of people from the congregation have spent many hours freshening up the beds – weeding, pruning, putting down mulch, planting annuals, and dead-heading the plants. The fountain has been repainted and is really pretty. As the old gospel hymn says, "I come to the garden alone...while the dew is still on the roses --- and the voice I hear --- falling on my ear---the Son of God discloses --- Come and walk with Him and talk with Him as you walk through the stations reminding us of what Christ went through during Holy Week, then sit a spell and enjoy God's beauty *In the Garden*."

In the pathway throughout the garden there are engraved bricks in honor or in memory of a loved one. Other bricks celebrate a special occasion, such as an anniversary, birth or graduation. You can order an engraved brick with an inscription of your choosing by picking up an order form in the church office or in the Welcome Center. The revenue from each ordered brick helps pay for upkeep of the garden. Engraved bricks are limited to three lines of fourteen characters each. The cost of each brick is \$50 each or if you choose to have a logo such as a cross, pet paw or heart, the cost is \$75.

"Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your

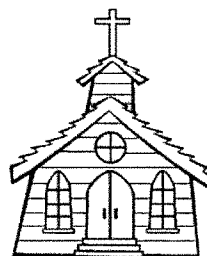
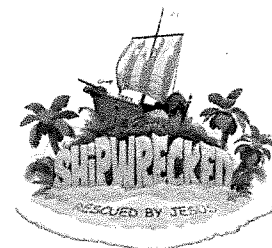
care, watching over them not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be."

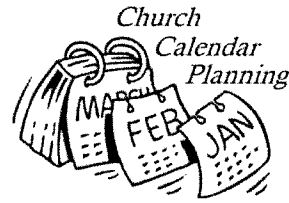

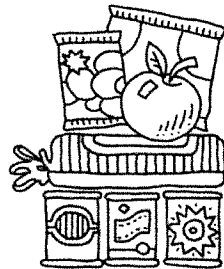
