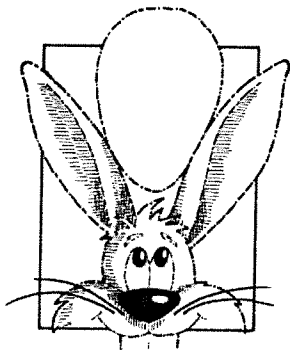

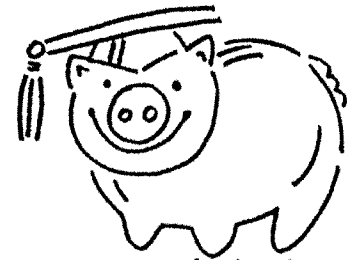
RUMC Shepherd Ministry

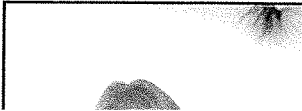

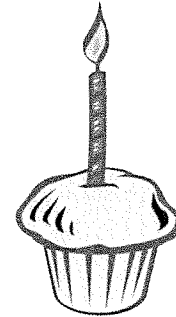
