

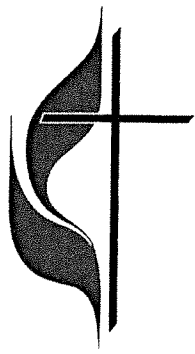

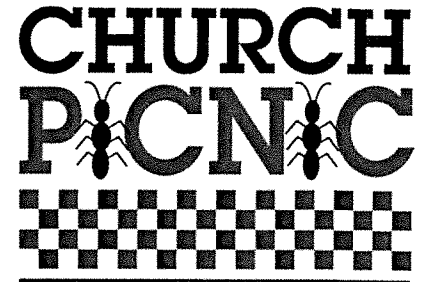

Everyone is invited, including your neighbors and friends to bring their pets on a leash or in a cage to the front lawn of the church.

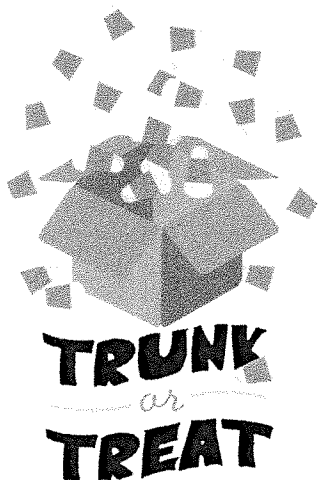


Sunday, October 14th

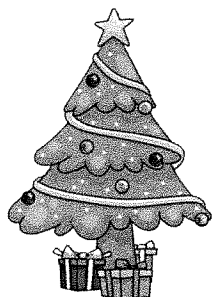


PASTOR

I find myself thinking about Barnabas this month. Barnabas was an early Christian believer in the book of Acts who was one of the smaller characters, but very important in the story of the early church. His real name was Joseph. Barnabas was a nickname given to him meaning 'Son of Encouragement.' (Acts 4:36) Throughout Acts we get snips and pieces of this man Barnabas who was an encourager to the early church. One important role he played was to support Paul who had been persecuting and killing early Christians until he was converted by an encounter with the risen Christ. (Acts 9) At that point Paul devoted his whole life to serving Christ, but the other disciples and believers were skeptical of his conversion and rejected him. It was through the encouragement and partnership of Barnabas with Paul that ministry grew (Acts 9:26-27)

Ministry here at Roseland UMC would not happen without my partnership with many leaders in the church for which I am very grateful. October is often seen as Pastor Appreciation month. I always find that a little uncomfortable to be highlighted in that manner because without the great staff here acting as a Barnabas to me ministry wouldn't happen. 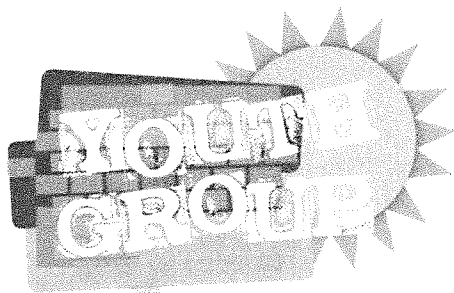
Bring in your unwanted gold, silver,

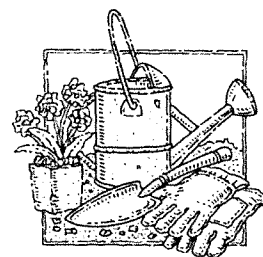

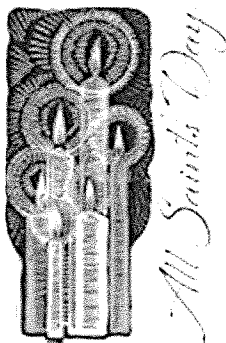
A special thank you goes to Susan and Ronnie Slade of *Clements Pest Control* for donating four bags of fertilizer.

On Sunday, November 4th, this moving service will give everyone an opportunity to light a candle to remember loved one's who have died. We will also read the name of those members who have died during the year.

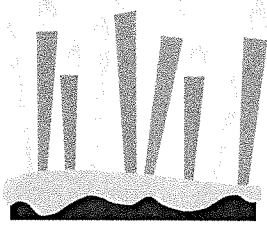

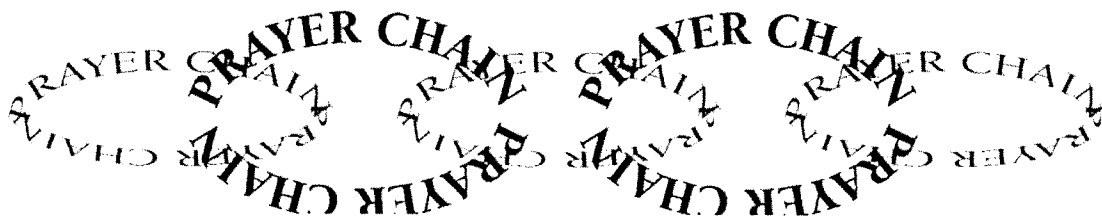
