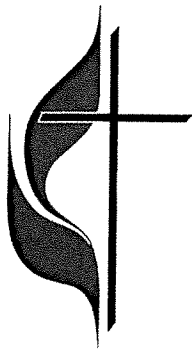

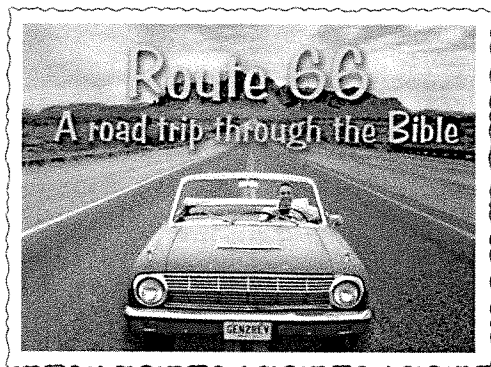

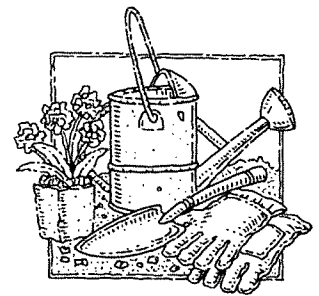


We have received many compliments on the Prayer Garden, and we are delighted to hear that you are enjoying it!

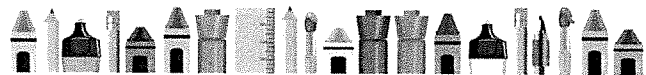

- This year you can choose to "adopt" a shoebox from our OCC Christmas Tree!

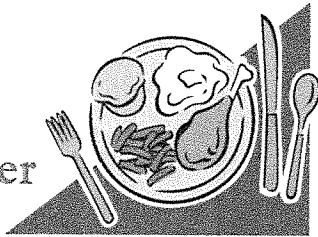

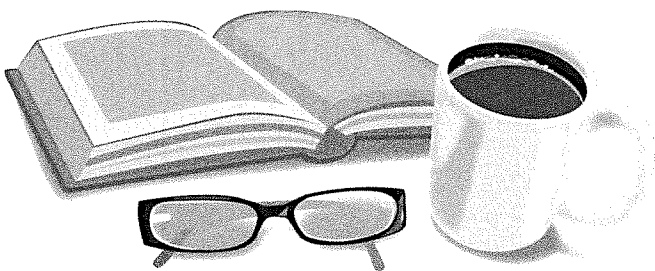
